Hi all,

I have seen a draft, still not final. The data of the outbreaks informed the changes. Here is what it looks like:

Mass gathering indoor 10 and outdoor 25.

Restaurants 25% seating indoors and still 100% outdoors. Bars (defined as 50% or greater sales from alcohol) no seating or dining indoors, but outdoors still 100% seated. Note: restaurant bars can provide bar stools at indoor bar if spaces apart 6 feet.

I did mention the concern of a broad brush stroke throughout the county on bars and the impacts of such. I was told that was discussed but probably not possible; there was concern of people driving outside of City to drink at bars.

As soon as final I will share.
